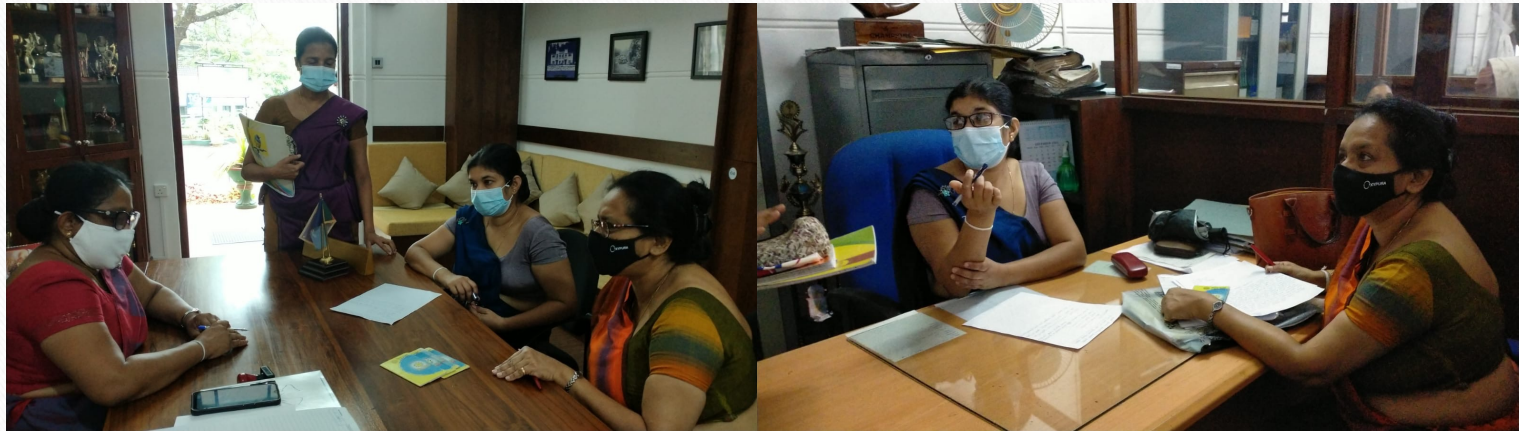


# Application Process


