

MGCAANA Undergraduate and Graduate Scholarship Program

- This scholarship is intended to provide the cost of books and material for a single semester for MGCAANA members pursuing undergraduate and graduate studies in the United States and Canada
- The scholarship is awarded to a student demonstrating outstanding academic achievements, leadership ability, participation in extracurricular activities.
- The scholarship of 250 USD was awarded to Dhanushka Palipana in 2022.





Vidya Scholarship Trust Fund (VSTF)

- VSTF was initiated in 2009 and is one of the oldest projects carried out by MGCAANA.
- VSTF is a legal trust registered in Sri Lanka and created by MGCAANA. It provides financial aid to economically disadvantaged students at Mahamaya Girls' College.
- In 2018, we reached our initial goal of 20,000 USD. As of May 2022, we have raised over 42,000 USD, and the goal was increased to 50,000 USD.



Nanda Pussegoda Leula Memorial Scholorship (NPLMS)

- This project provides financial aid to economically disadvantaged students at Mahamaya Girls' College as well as to a student-run organization at Mahamaya to perform a community service project, using a personal donation given by Mrs. Nanda Pussegoda Leula's daughter Kanthi Leula in memory of her mother, who was a valued alumna of MGCAANA.
- We received a donation of 2500 USD in 2021-2022



Annual Charity Donations

 A donation of 100 USD each was made to Puppies behind Bars (USA) and to Breast Cancer Society of Canada.





Charities were chosen by the BOD. Criteria for choosing a charity can be found on the MGCAANA website.




Newsletter
